

2011 2-Man Match Play Championship

Format:

Net Best-Ball, Match Play

The tournament is comprised of up to 32 two-man teams. Teams will be randomly assigned in a bracketed format (like an NCAA BB tournament). Winners advance to compete for the title of 2-Man Match Play Champions.

Teams must register in the Pro Shop by June 9, 2011.

Select your teammate, but you must have no more than an 8-stroke differential in handicaps. If the difference exceeds 8 strokes during the course of the tournament, the higher handicap will be adjusted downward.

The match will be played off the lowest handicapped player in the group, moving to a 0 and strokes being applied accordingly. Players will use the most recent Elk Rapids course handicap revision posted on the Handicap bulletin board for each match.

All players will play from the white tees.

All participants must be ERGC members and have either a ERGC established handicap (almost everyone who played in either the early or late leagues in 2010 has one) or an USGA handicap established elsewhere. Entry fee is \$10 per man. ERGC handicaps are posted on the bulletin board in the back area of the locker room and will be updated weekly.

Round Information:

Each round of the tournament will be comprised of an 18-hole match, with the time to be set by the competitors themselves. Notify the pro shop that you will be playing an 18-hole match.

Round 1 officially begins Monday, June 13th and ends Thursday June 30th. Round 2 will begin on Thursday July 7th and end on July 21st. Deadlines for subsequent rounds will be posted.

It will be the responsibility of the players to coordinate the completion of their match by each deadline. If both teams cannot agree upon a time to play their match, then the team that is available to play on the last available day advances. If neither team is able to play that day, a coin toss will choose which team advances.
